



RENTAL GEAR - 7 Night Departures

We highly recommend that divers bring their own gear. Advanced diving conditions that are common in Galapagos truly call for divers to be in their own, known and proper fitting gear. Please know in advance that sizes and selection are extremely limited. Divers should bring their own dive computer(s), 1-2mm gloves and their own hooded vest and layering garments for added thermal protection.

Full Gear Rental Package – \$250 for full set (BCD, Reg-set, & wetsuit, mask, snorkel, and fins). Excludes computer.

BCD – \$80 per charter

Reg & Gauge Set – \$80 per charter

Computer – \$75 per charter

7mm Wetsuit – \$45 per charter

Fins/Booties – \$25 per charter

Mask & Snorkel – \$25 per charter

100 cubic foot/15 Liter tank upgrade - \$60 per charter
